



# Cyclepath Presents the 2nd Calaveras Time Trial

## A time trial for individuals and tandems.

**Course:** 10 miles on excellent to fair pavement, this is an out and back course. One major climb of 350 feet going to the turn. Start and finish are located approx. 300 yards South of I-680 on Calaveras Road. Turn at the 5.0 miles mark, 1 mile up the hill and past Geary road and retrace.

**Roads:** Calaveras Road, near Sunol, Alameda County.

**Registration:** At the Niles Canyon Railroad depot at the junction of Main street, Sunol and Kilkare Road. Registration opens at 7:00 AM and will close 15 minutes before last man off. Riders depart the start timekeeper at 60 second intervals.

**Directions:** From I-680, take the Highway 84 exit and go north on Paloma Road (84) to Sunol. Bear left on 84 onto Niles Canyon road and then turn right on to Main street to train depot. Follow signs to parking. From Niles Canyon (Fremont), exit at Sunol and follow signs to parking.

**Categories:** E5, E4, E3, P1/2, W4, W3, W35+, W1/2/3, tandem and co-ed tandems, M55+ male, M45+ 3/4, M45+1/2/3/4, M35+ 1/2/3, M35+ cat 4.

First rider will depart the start at 8:01 and following riders will depart in the above category order at 1 minute intervals.

Please car pool if possible

**Prizes:** Prizes will awarded for 1st - 3rd where categories have 6 or more participants with over \$1000 value in prizes provided by Cyclepath Pleasanton, San Mateo, and Hayward plus other sponsors. There will be an omnium prize for each category in combination your placing at the Memorial Day Criterium promoted by SJBC on May 25th. *Prizes TBD*

**Rules:** Held under the rules and regulations of the USAC. A 2009 USAC license required or 1-day license must be purchased (for cat 4 and below only). The Promoter reserves the right to add or combine fields.

## Entry fees and other stuff:

- Intermediate times recorded at the turn will be posted if feasible.
- No warming up on the course.
- Please use bathrooms provided by the organizers and Niles Canyon Railroad, who are kindly allowing us to use their facilities. A porta potty will be located at the start area. Anyone found relieving a call of nature that could in anyway be to the detriment of the event will be DQ'd, no arguments.
- \$25 per person, pre-entry before midnight, Tuesday 19th May, 2009. Second race same day \$10.00 per person. District and National champ's race for \$2.00 (one race for \$2.00) in event and category championship held. Fees include USCF and NCNCA surcharges. No refunds for missed starting times.
- Visit Sportsbaseonline to enter using the joys of the World Wide Web, entry fee does not include SBO surcharge.
- It takes about 10 minutes to get from registration to the start, so do not be late. (Someone will).
