



# Cyclepath Presents the 2nd Altamont TTT

## A Team time trial for teams of 3 OR 4 riders.

**Course:** 15.7 miles on excellent to fair pavement, this is an out and back course with a significant climb each way. Start and finish are located approx. 300 yards East of Greenville Road on Altamont Pass Road. Turn at the 7.8 miles mark, before Grant Line Road and retrace.

**Roads:** Altamont Pass Road, near Livermore, Alameda County.

**Registration:** On Altamont Pass Road, 100 yards east of the Greenville Road junction. Registration opens at 7:00 AM and will close 15 minutes before last team off. Teams depart the start timekeeper at 60 second intervals.

**Directions:** From I-580 East, take the Greenville Road exit and go left on South Front Road. Left on Greenville to Altamont. Follow signs and marshals directions to parking. From I-580 west, exit at Greenville Road, turn onto North Front Road and follow signs and marshals directions to parking.

**Teams:** All teams to be teams of 3 OR 4 riders. (3rd rider to count for time and the 3<sup>rd</sup> rider has to finish with the lead two.)

**Categories:** E5, E4, E3, E2, P1/2, M35+, M45+, M55+, W3, W4, W1/2/3, W masters 35+ 4. Riders of different categories can combine but the higher category results will prevail. The W3 and W4 categories will count toward the 2010 Women's Racing Series team competition - for more info see [www.bawcycling.com/series](http://www.bawcycling.com/series).

First team will depart the start at 8:01 and riders will depart in the above category order at 1 minute intervals.

**Prizes:** \$1000 Value in gift cards plus merchandise provided by our wonderful sponsor Cyclepath cycles of Hayward, Pleasanton and San Mateo. Prizes will go 3 teams deep in each category. Prizes also provided by Chipotle Mexican Grill.

**Rules:** Held under USAC Cycling event permit. A 2010 USAC license required or 1-day license must be purchased (for cat 5 men and Cat 4 women only). The Promoter reserves the right to add or combine fields.

### **Entry fees and other stuff: THERE IS NO ENTRY ON THE DAY.**

No warming up on the course. Please use bathrooms provided. A porta potty will be located at the start area. Anyone found relieving a call of nature that could in anyway be to the detriment of the event **will be DQ'd** (Your team mates will love you for it!)

Wheel choice – The cross wind on this course can be significant. Bring alternates to your disks / deep section rims, just in case!

\$25 per person, pre-entry before midnight, March 30th, 2010. Second race same day \$10.00 per person.
