**Present the NCNCA Championship 4 person / 3 person TTT**  
**Saturday July 9<sup>th</sup>, 2011.**



**Course:** 15.7 miles on excellent to fair pavement, this is an out and back course with a climb each way. Start is located approx. 300 yards East of Greenville Road on Altamont Pass Road. Finish is located ½ mile East from Greenville, at Goecken Road. Turn at the 7.8 miles mark, before Grant Line Road and retrace.

**Roads:** Altamont Pass Road, near Livermore, Alameda County.

**Directions:** From I-580 from either direction, exit at the Greenville Road exit. Follow signs to parking and registration.

No warming up on the course. Please use bathrooms provided. A porta potty will be located at the start area. Anyone found relieving a call of nature that could in anyway be to the detriment of the event will be DQ'd

Registration opens at 7:00 AM and will close 15 minutes before last team off. Teams depart the start timekeeper at 2 minute intervals. First team off at 08:01 AM. Three person teams can start. Three must finish together minimum. Third person across the line counts for finish time. Teams with 3 people are not timed separately from 4 person teams. Teams will start in the category order below.

Women Masters 55+

Prizes for championship events will be medals only for top 3 teams (if medals are not available, an alternative will be provided, such as trophy, certificate) Members of the winning team are entitled to purchase a district champions uniform. All members of masters teams must be in that age category or above. All members of teams competing in the championship events must be residing within the NCNCA District. All members of teams competing in the championship event should be members of teams that are within the NCNCA district.

Prizes for non-championship events will be awards only for top 3 teams. \$600 value in merchandise or gift certificates.  
Day of registration available for NON-championship categories only.

**Rules:** USAC event permit. A 2011 USAC license required or 1-day license must be purchased (for cat 4 & 5 men and Cat 4 women only).

#### Entry fees and other stuff:

**Start times will be posted on the promoter's website 48 hours in advance of race day.**

**There will be NO technical check. It can be VERY windy, please bring an alternative to deep section / disk wheels.**

\$100 per team, **PRE ENTRY ONLY** for Championship entries, before midnight PDT, July 5th, 2011. Day of entry available for non-championship categories. Fees include USAC and NCNCA surcharges but not the Sports Base Online surcharge. No refunds for missed starting times or lost partners. Enter using the joys of the World Wide Web at Sportsbaseonline or by snail mail.
